### ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Garage Wine Co. began quite literally in Pilar and Derek's garage with the intent to revive old vineyards in marginalized Chilean communities to make coveted wines. It is still a very DIY project from vineyard to bottle.

GWCo makes wines from a series of individual parcels, small lots /  
bottlings of 8 -22 barrels

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### ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Across the creek from GWC's Truqui Carignan vines.

Sandy, granitic soils and sub-soils, cracked to allow root depth  
Farmed by hand and horse with traditional dry farming methods

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### ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvest, naturally fermented with native yeasts

Caps punched down by hand, pressing was strictly manual

Lignified stems re-introduced after crush (approx 20%)

Fermented outside. Aged over two winters in third use barrels

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### TASTING NOTES

"Brought from a grower who thought he'd planted Garnacha but ended up with Syrah, this is a first release from Garage Wine and comes from some of the youngest vines on its books. Taut, tangy and refreshing with no white pepper notes but plenty of freshness and mineralogy, this is a taut, stony, black-fruited number with top notes of fennel and thyme, a hint of meaty reduction and a long, focused finish." - TA
